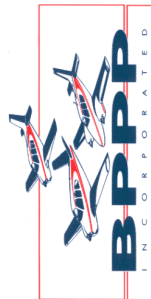

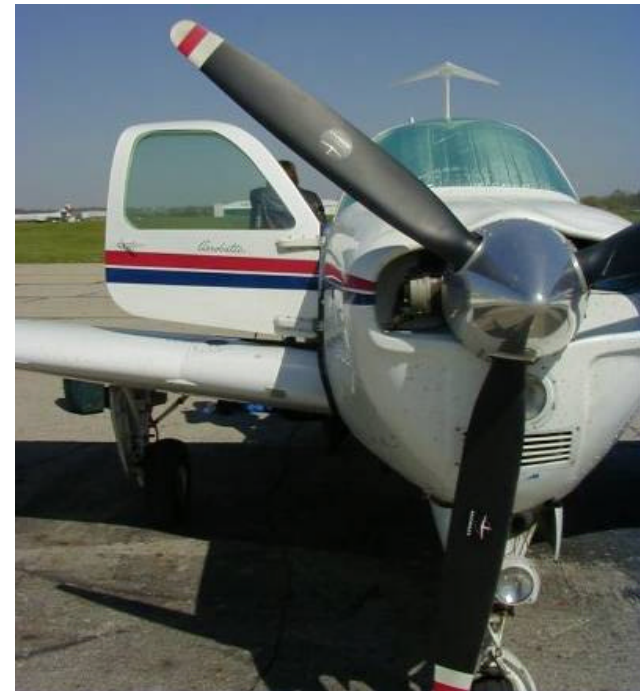

Companion Course
